RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REVISED AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR LEAD INSPECTOR SERVICES (NOTE: Revision of Resolution 2019-11 passed on January 22, 2019)

WHEREAS, Kenneth J. Walls, BS, has submitted a proposal indicating he will provide lead inspection services effective January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 to the Commission at a rate of \$40.00 / hour and a cost not to exceed \$17,000.00 or 425 hours for the purposes of the NJ Childhood Lead Exposure Prevention (CLEP) Grant ; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth J. Walls, BS has completed and submitted a C.19 Business Entity Disclosure Certification, Stockholder Disclosure Certificate, and C.271 Political Contribution Disclosure Form certifying that Kenneth J. Walls, BS has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee associated with any of the Municipalities serviced by the Commission in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Kenneth J. Walls from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract, and
