RESOLUTION 2024- 29

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REVISED SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF A COMMUNICABLE DISEASE PROGRAM, REGIONAL HEALTH EDUCATION AND OTHER SPECIALIZED SERVICES BETWEEN THE JERSEY SHORE REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION (JSRHC) AND THE CITY OF LONG BRANCH

WHEREAS, the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission desires to provide public health shared service with the City of Long Branch as members of the Monmouth Public Health Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Monmouth Public Health Consortium (hereafter MPHCC), a partnership of local governments and local health agencies, will coordinate the provision of these new shared and regionalized public health services, in a manner that is cost effective for all participating agencies.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Long Branch recognizes that the sharing of Regional Public Health Specialized Expertise, as mandated by the State of New Jersey, will be beneficial to protecting the public health, welfare & safety of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the JSRHC can provide communicable disease control program, communicable disease nursing, health education and other specialized public health services and Recipient requires such services in accordance with Chapter 52, Public Health Practice Standards of Performance for Local Boards of Health in New Jersey, N.J.A.C. 8:52, which can be provided without detracting from services currently being provided by the JSRHC and the City of Long Branch;

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement is January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission that the Commission President and Health Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract agreement with the City of Long Branch pursuant to the terms and conditions of the attached agreement; and

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be on file in the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission and available for inspection as required by law and also be filed with the Department of Community Affairs and the Department of Health.
