RESOLUTION 2025-31 Sale of Capital Property

WHEREAS, the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission (herein” JSRHC”) has established and adopted a “Procedure for Public Sale of Capital Property” for the sale of items no longer needed for public use; and;

WHEREAS, the “Procedure for Public Sale of Capital Property” first offers the vehicles for sale to its towns by way of a communication from the JSRHC Office Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, it was explained to the Commission at the June 24, 2025 meeting that the vehicle is surplus and no longer needed and;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Spring Lake expressed an interest in purchasing the listed vehicle, being fully informed of its condition; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Spring Lake offered the price of \$5000.00 and the Health Officer, and Commission President have approved the sale; and

FUTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission authorizes its Health Officer to execute and sign on behalf of the JSRHC the Contract for Sale or documents transferring the vehicle title to said Borough at the appropriate time; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be on file in the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission and available for inspection as required by law.
