**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ROBERT WOOD JOHNSON
BARNABAS HEALTH CORPORATE CARE AT MONMOUTH MEDICAL CENTER
OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, there is a need for occupational safety and health services for the employees of Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission (hereinafter referred to as “JSRHC”); and

WHEREAS, JSRHC had a previous agreement with Monmouth Medical Center for Occupational Health Services; and

WHEREAS, JSRHC seeks to obtain occupational health services for the review of medical evaluation questionnaires (\$21.00) and for respiratory fit testing and pulmonary function tests (\$48.00); and

WHEREAS, JSRHC also desires to have access to occupational health services on a case-by-case basis, in order to meet the occupational health needs of staff and to provide a method for employee protection under our workforce development and employee safety program;

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose in the 2026 budget, under:
Public Health Initiatives – Clinics (PHI)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission approve the 2026 Agreement and attached fee schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Health Officer is authorized to sign the agreement under the caption of:

Occupational Health and Medical Services for the Agreement between RWJ Barnabas Health Monmouth Medical Center Occupational Health Services and the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission.
