RESOLUTION 2026 - 35

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE FREEHOLD AREA HEALTH DEPARTMENT (FAHD) AND THE JERSEY SHORE REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION (JSRHC) FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH OUTBREAK PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the FAHD is serving as the lead agency and fiscal agent for the grant on behalf of the Governmental Public Health Partnership (GPHP) of Monmouth County. The purpose of this Agreement is to support organizational time and resources dedicated to the implementation of the grant.

WHEREAS, the JSRHC will collaborate with FAHD in the planning, coordination, implementation, and evaluation of grant activities, as requested; and participate in meetings, workgroups, and other project-related activities necessary to support successful implementation of grant objectives.

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement is July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, contingent upon grant funding availability.

WHEREAS, the FAHD shall provide JSRHC with grant funding in the amount of \$14,250 during the period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Funds shall be used to offset staff and organizational costs associated with participation in grant activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the JSRHC that the Commission President and Health Officer are hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract agreement with the FAHD pursuant to the terms and conditions of the attached agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be on file in the Jersey Shore Regional Health Commission and available for inspection as required by law and also be filed with the Department of Community Affairs and the Department of Health.
